SPACE AGE TRIKE VISITS AIRVENTURE AND STURGIS

"History is being made as the Super Sky Cycle, a flying motorcycle, visits Airventure 2009, the largest gathering of experimental aircraft in the world, and then attends the Sturgis bike rally, which is the largest motorcycle gathering in the country", said Valorie White, the Executive Vice President of The Butterfly LLC.

"On the 40th anniversary of NASA landing on the moon, the average person can fly and drive a space age trike from their garage at home", said White.

"The unique thing about the SSC is that it is registered as an experimental aircraft and also as a street legal motorcycle", said White.

The Super Sky Cycle will fulfill the dreams of many who always wanted a Fly-Drive Vehicle in the garage. A vehicle that they could drive to the store and also fly anywhere they want to go. Yes, the Jetsons would be proud.

The Butterfly LLC is marketing SSC kits and dealerships to the public. The SSC kits can be built as a homebuilt motorcycle (trike) and as an experimental 51% homebuilt aircraft. The SSC is a street legal motorcycle with brakes, lights, and mirrors and is also legal to fly as an Experimental aircraft.

"The SSC isn't just an idea or a cartoon. We have been driving and flying the SSC since 2005. The new production

model has a retro-space age look with fins and Cadillac style bullet tail lights. The attention the SSC gets from the public is unbelievable", said White.

The SSC can be seen at Airventure (July 27th-August 2nd) at the Ultralight area (space #918) and at Sturgis, SD (August 5th-9th) at 2112 Dolan Creek Road.
